LIPHA SPECIFICATIONS FOR 2019

LIPHA LOW HUNTERS: No restrictions as to horse/pony or rider, no restrictions as to cross entering. Fences 2'6". At the discretion of Show Management a Handy Hunter Class may be offered in this division. USEF specs apply.

LIPHA LOW CHILDRENS/ADULT EQUITATION: Open to junior & adult exhibitors. Fences 2'. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation class or hunter class where fences exceed 2'6".

LIPHA PRE-MINI 2'6" MEDAL/MEDIUM ADULT MEDAL EQUITATION: Exhibitors must have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. To be shown over a lower and/ or modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Riders may not compete in any classes exceeding 2'6" at the same show that they compete in the Pre-Mini or Medium Adult Division. Fences not to exceed 2'6.

LIPHA ROSS REISNER MINI MEDAL: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Rider must be a Member of the LIPHA as of the date he/she competes in a Junior PHA Medal Class in order for points to count. Fences at 3'0". The LIPHA sponsors Equitation classes in several divisions. These classes may be held at any show, USEF member or non-member as long as LIPHA permission has been obtained.

LIPHA HIGH ADULT MEDAL: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Fences at 3'0" and may be combined with Ross Reisner Mini Medal if there are fewer than 3 entries. Year end awards may be combined with MINI Medal if entries warrant.

LIPHA JUNIOR MEDAL – To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Fences at 3'6".

**** LIPHA JUMPERS, CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPERS will be combined for year end award based on points acquired in the 2nd class of their competition division. If entries warrant in any of the levels/divisions, separate awards will be offered.**

**** COMBINING/DIVIDING JUMPER SECTIONS AT SHOWS:** If there are fewer than 3 entries in any section, the sections may be combined at management's discretion allowing each section to compete at their respective height to fill division. **EXAMPLE: LIPHA JUMPERS CAN BE COMBINED WITH LOW JUMPERS FOR DIVISION TO BE FILLED AND COUNT TOWARD YEAR END.** Points will be applied for year-end awards based on the respective height. If sections are combined a horse can only compete at one height in each class. All Jumper classes open to horses and ponies. Child/Adult Jumpers - Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year and adults who hold a current USEF Amateur certification.

LIPHA SPECIFICATIONS FOR 2019

NEW CHANGES FOR 2019 YEAR END AWARDS

Long Island High Score Awards Association has been merged with the Long Island PHA. Beginning in 2019, you will need to become a member of the LIPHA for your points to count toward year-end awards. To become a member, go to www.lipha.org and sign up.

ONE CLASS in the division will be a point class that will count toward LIPHA year-end awards. Riders must compete in a minimum of 4 shows in the same division and on the same horse in Hunter and Jumper divisions to be eligible for year-end awards.

A rider must be a member of the LIPHA and register for award points in order to be eligible for a year-end award.

Rider Eligibility on Ponies: In accordance with USEF rules, adults may show ponies in classes that are not restricted to junior riders, however that pony may not be shown in any junior exhibitor class at the same show. See USEF rules for Zone and National divisions.

I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the Long Island Professional Horseman's Association.
2. All points won at this show will count double towards the LIPHA end of years awards. In order to be eligible for an award in any LIPHA section, the horse, pony or rider must have shown in that section in at least four member shows.
3. **ENTRIES CLOSE WED MAY 8, 2019. POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 8, 2019 WITH AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$15 PER CLASS.**
4. **Refunds** for entries will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate attesting to the inability of horse, due to illness or injury to participate, and the veterinarian's certificate must be received prior to the start of the show. If a horse has shown in one class in a division, it will not be eligible for a refund. Refunds will be mailed. There will be a \$35.00 office charge for all scratches.
5. **Measurement cards and Amateur certification** must be presented at the horse show office before back numbers will be released. To speed processing, management would appreciate exhibitors sending a photo-copy with their entry blanks.
6. No entry will be accepted or recorded unless signed by the owner/agent and trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.
7. A fee of \$50, plus collection fees, will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
8. A limited number of permanent stalls are available on a first come, first serve basis. NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT ADVANCED PAYMENT and STALL FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE. Stall fee is \$125 a day and must be received by the show secretary or before the closing date.
STALLS CLOSING DATE IS APRIL 12, 2019.
9. Prize money will be awarded by check written to cash if requested. Otherwise it will be subtracted from exhibitors' show bill. Prize money awarded in all Classic/Derby classes as follows: 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 15%, 4th 15%, 5th 10% and 6th 8%. All checks will be void after 30 days. The owner of any horse or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded must provide a Social Security or Federal ID on the entry.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes, and to change ring designations/judges in the interest of time and /or safety. Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles in accordance with USEF Rule HU120.2
11. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management, their officials, employees and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the LIPHA, and the officials, employees, officers, sponsors and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

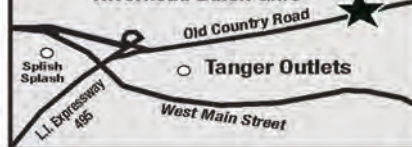

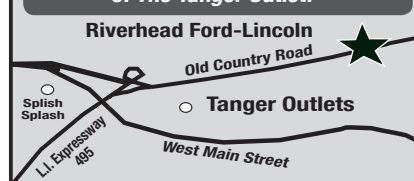
