LIPHA LOW HUNTERS: No restrictions as to horse/pony or rider, no restrictions as to cross entering. Fences 2'6". At the discretion of Show Management a Handy Hunter Class may be offered in this division. USEF specs apply.

LIPHA LOW CHILDRENS/ADULT EQUITATION: Open to junior & adult exhibitors. Fences 2'. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation class or hunter class where fences exceed 2'6".

LIPHA PRE-MINI 2'6" MEDAL/MEDIUM ADULT MEDAL EQUITATION: Exhibitors must have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. To be shown over a lower and/ or modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Riders may not compete in any classes exceeding 2'6" at the same show that they compete in the Pre-Mini or Medium Adult Division. Fences not to exceed 2'6.

LIPHA ROSS REISNER MINI MEDAL: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. - *** COMBINING/DIVIDING JUMPER SECTIONS AT SHOWS: If there are fewer than 3 entries in any section, the sections may be combined at management's discretion allowing each section to compete at their respective height to fill division. NEW CHANGES FOR 2019 YEAR END AWARDS

Long Island High Score Awards Association has been merged with the Long Island PHA. Beginning in 2019, you will need to become a member of the LIPHA for your points to count toward year-end awards. To become a member, go to www.lipha.org and sign up.

ONE CLASS in the division will be a point class that will count toward LIPHA year-end awards. Riders must compete in a minimum of 4 shows in the same division and on the same horse in Hunter and Jumper divisions to be eligible for year-end awards.

A rider must be a member of the LIPHA and register for award points in order to be eligible for a vear-end award.

Rider Eligibility on Ponies: In accordance with USEF rules, adults may show ponies in classes that are not restricted to junior riders, however that pony may not be shown in any junior exhibitor class at the same show. See USEF rules for Zone and National divisions.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

The following classes will follow the USEF Rule Book:

The following sections will follow the USHJA Zone Specifications:

Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse, Adult Amateur Hunter, Children's Jumper, Adult Amateur Jumper.

*** The second (2nd) over fences class of an awards division will be the LIPHA point class and points will count only for that class. Exception: LIPHA Opportunity Walk/Trot will always be the first (1st) class of the division.

In the event of a discrepancy between LIPHA specs and USHJA Stirrup Cup specs, the USHJA specs are to be used.

*** NEW DIVISION AWARD: LIPHA BEGINNER WALK/TROT EQUITATION: Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not showed in any class where jumping a course of jumps. Once a rider competes in the mini-short stirrup or above they are no longer eligible for beginner equitation. May be split into two sections Under 8 years of age and 9 and over. The first class of this division will count towards your LIPHA award.

***NEW DIVISION AWARD: LIPHA MINI SHORT STIRRUP: Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders who compete in the short stirrup or above are no longer eligible for the mini short stirrup. Riders to jump a course of which will not include a change of direction on course. Fences 18"

The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Every class offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the Long Island Professional Horseman's Association.
- 2. All points won at this show will count double towards the LIPHA end of years awards. In order to be eligible for an award in any LIPHA section, the horse, pony or rider must have shown in that section in at least four member shows.

3. ENTRIES CLOSE WED MAY 8, 2019. POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 8, 2019 WITH AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$15 PER CLASS.

- 4. **Refunds** for entries will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate attesting to the inability of horse, due to illness or injury to participate, and the veterinarian's certificate must be received prior to the start of the show. If a horse has shown in one class in a division, it will not be eligible for a refund. Refunds will be mailed. There will be a \$35.00 office charge for all scratches.
- 5. **Measurement cards and Amateur certification** must be presented at the horse show office before back numbers will be released. To speed processing, management would appreciate exhibitors sending a photocopy with their entry blanks.
- 6. No entry will be accepted or recorded unless signed by the owner/agent and trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.
- 7. A fee of \$50, plus collection fees, will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
- 8. A limited number of permanent stalls are available on a first come, first serve basis. NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT ADVANCED PAYMENT and STALL FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE. Stall fee is \$125 a day and must be received by the show secretary or before the closing date.

STALLS CLOSING DATE IS APRIL 12, 2019.

- 9. Prize money will be awarded by check written to cash if requested. Otherwise it will be subtracted from exhibitors' show bill. Prize money awarded in all Classic/Derby classes as follows: 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 15%, 4th 15%, 5th 10% and 6th 8%. All checks will be void after 30 days. The owner of any horse or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded must provide a Social Security or Federal ID on the entry.
- 10. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes, and to change ring designations/judges in the interest of time and /or safety. Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles in accordance with USEF Rule HU120.2
- 11. Every animal entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management, their officials, employees and sponsors shall not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property, which may occur for any reason during the show and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the LIPHA, and the officials, employees, officers, sponsors and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.
- 12. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.





TAYLOR HARRIS INSURANCE SERVICES NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MEDAL Open to all Junior members of the USEF and Equine Canada who have never competed in any of the following National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6": Pessoa/US Medal; ASPCA Maclay; USEF Talent Search (East or West); Jump Canada Medal Finals; WIHS Junior Equitation Finals; Hunterdon Cup; North American Equitation Championship. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the First round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class. Approximately forty riders will be invited to compete in the finals and will be chosen as follows; the high point rider in each of the regional series will be invited, along with additional riders working from the top down on the National Standings list for the qualifying period. Any unfilled slots will be chosen by continuing down the National Standings list



313. Robert L. Hoskins Mini Medal.

Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in a USEF Medal or ASPCA Maclay class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles not exceeding 3' which must include an combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required. Tests 1-10. Only one rider per horse.

314. Hugh J.B. Cassidy, III Mini Maclay.

Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in a USEF Medal or ASPCA Maclay class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight obstacles not exceeding 3' with or without wings. A minimum of 12 riders if available are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. Tests 1-10. Only one rider per horse.
